HOW TO PLAY:

YOU'LL NEED:

- ★ Paper and pencil for keeping score
- ★ A timer such as a phone or watch
- ★ The printed charade words and scissors to cut them
- ★ A bag or bowl for people to randomly select the charade words from
- ★ Something silly and festive for the 'actor' to wear when playing out their charade
- ★ A prize for the winner/winning team (maybe they get to enjoy the last piece of pav!)
- ★ If playing in groups, don't forget to give fun Christmas-themed names to each team

RULES:

This can be played individually or in teams by following the rules below:

- 1 Choose a player to start the game. The player selects a card at random (no peaking!)
- 2 The player acts out the word or phrase on the card they have chosen to the other players- no speaking allowed!

Some common action clues used in charades include:

- ★ Sounds like: Touch your ear
 - ★ A person/character: Stand with your hands on hips
 - ★ Number of words: Hold up the number of fingers in the phrase. When acting out the first word, hold up one finger, then two fingers before the second, etc.
 - ★ A song: Pretend to sing
 - ★ A movie: Pretend to crank an old fashioned movie camera
- 3 The other players must watch carefully and call out their guesses. The first person to guess the correct word or phrase takes the next turn - it's that easy!
 - 4 Allocate points to each person/team for each correct guess. The person or team with the most points at the end of the game wins
